Established in 1945, the Manheim operating location has ranked as the world’s largest wholesale auction facility since 1959. The new \$38 million reconditioning center is designed to handle the high volume of vehicles that pass through the location each month, offering customers state-of-the-art recon services. - Paint and body shop capable of handling 350 vehicles per day
- On-site Dent Wizard and Chip Wizard
- 14 detail lanes capable of handling 700 vehicles per day
- 19 vehicle service bays capable of handling 150 vehicles per day
- Wireless technology to track vehicle progress throughout the recon cycle
- Inspection facility handling more than 500 vehicles per day.

The facility features conservation efforts, including the installation of Manheim’s most advanced wastewater treatment system. The system reduces the facility’s water demand by 60 percent by producing 42,000 gallons of reusable water each day.

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“The system is so advanced that the treated recycled wastewater is better than the well water we started with,” said Charles McClung, director of engineering.

In addition, the paint booths will utilize water-based paint to minimize air pollutants.
